
SPORTS & GAMES








NCC, SCOUTS & GUIDES, CUBS & BULBUL

RESULTS

ADMISSIONS

Admissions are open in accordance with the seats vacant in the respective classes, to all irrespective of caste, creed or race. A child must have completed a minimum of 3 years to a maximum of 4 years as of 1 April for admission to Nursery and correspondingly for higher classes. The school lays great stress on the character formation. Mere academic excellence will not make the candidate eligible for admission. The Principal, in consultation with the governing body, is the sole arbitrator in this matter.

ADMISSION TO CLASS-XI

Apart from the minimum qualification required by the CBSE, the school has its own norms of eligibility for admission to class XI.

- High academic performance in classes IX & X.
- Final marks of class IX & Pre-Board of class X will also be taken into consideration
- Regularity of work and attendance in classes VIII-X.
- · Only those students will be admitted to class XI, who in the opinion of the Principal have displayed mental ability and high moral character and have a serious application to studies.

SCHOOL TIMINGS



The school functions from 7:20 am to 1:30 pm during summer and 8:10 am to 2:00 pm during winter, for children of classes from LKG to 12. Class nursery students attend school from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Saturdays are observed as half-day, with school timing up to 12:00 noon for classes LKG to 12.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Our school uniform is perfectly designed to ensure comfort and suitability for both summer and winter seasons. Apart from regular school uniform, the students of classes 1 to 12 are equally divided into four groups/houses i.e. Blue, Green, Gold and Red. These house uniforms are different from the regular uniforms and are to be worn every Wednesday and Saturday. The house uniforms may be recommended to change after every three years from implementation.



TRANSPORTATION/CONVEYANCE

Transport facility is made available by private transport service providers and by the school as well, to almost every part of the Jhotwara area. The vehicles are equipped with GPS, CCTV and speed governing technologies to safeguard the children. Apart from the technologies installed, every bus has a separate bus attendant to take extra care of the children. The children studying in classes 11 & 12 have to arrange their transport on their own if they leave early or stay back in school for extra classes.

PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS VERY CAREFULLY BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH THE REGISTRATION FORM ONLINE

- 1. The Registration Form should be filled out only by the parents (father or mother).
- Filling out the Registration Form for a child does not guarantee admission to the class applied for.
- 2. The filled-in Registration Form has to be submitted to the school office on or before the last date mentioned in the registration form between 9:00 am & 12:00 noon.
 - The registration form will be considered invalid and cancelled if not deposited on or before the last date.
- 3. Date of birth certificate is compulsory for applicants seeking admission to classes Nursery, LKG, HKG & First.
- The student's name, date of birth and father's & mother's name on the date of birth certificate should not be handwritten.
- 4. A school studying certificate is mandatory for admission to class second & above.
 - A school studying certificate should consist of the student's name, date of birth, father's & mother's name and the class in which the student is studying presently.
- 5. The date of birth, once recorded in the school records, will not change at later stage in any case. The date of birth filled online should be the same as that on the date of birth certificate.
 - The School Management has the right to cancel the registration form if differences are found in the age filled online with that of the birth certificate.
- In no case will a student be admitted to a class higher than that for which they are entitled/eligible according to their age. (As per CBSE, a child's age should not be less than 14 years at the time of registration with the Board in class-9).
- 6. The particulars from the birth certificate or school studying certificate without any alteration should be filled out in the registration form and admission form after the confirmation of the admission.
 - The registration or admission stands cancelled if the details are not the same as written on the birth certificate or school studying certificate.
 - The Transfer Certificate (TC) should also contain the exact details mentioned in the date of birth or school studying certificate.
- 7. Admissions will only be confirmed based on the child's interaction/interview/test held for subjects Hindi, English and Mathematics. Questions will be asked from the syllabus of the class the student is studying presently. A separate syllabus for the exam/test will not be provided. The duration of the exam/test will be one hour and thirty minutes.
- 8. The result of the interaction/interview/test will be **declared and made available on the school website**, (www.stteresasschooljpr.in) after two working days from the date of the interaction/interview/test conducted.







- a) Receipt of online Payment, of Rs.1000/-, towards administrative and registration charges.
- b) Two passport-size photos of the child and one of each parent. (Strictly latest/recent photo)
- c) Photocopy of the date of birth certificate of the child. Original must be produced for verification. (*Compulsory for admission in classes Nursery, LKG, HKG &First*).
- d) Photocopy of half-yearly mark sheet of the class in which the child studying presently. (Final mark sheet if applying after March)
- e) School studying certificate, in original, from the school where the child is currently enrolled. (Compulsory for all classes)
- f) Photocopies of Aadhar Card of the child and both parents.
- g) Photocopy of proof of present residence.
